APPROVAL OF PLAN NUMBER P-20885

BACKGROUND

- 1. On December 13, 2021, Tyler Thulin, on behalf of the Central Nebraska Public Power and Irrigation District filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) an Application for Approval of Plans for Dams, plan P-20885, and associated specifications.
- 2. The plan, P-20885, is for modifications to Elwood Dam, which is subject to the Safety of Dams and Reservoirs Act. The dam is located in the NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 8 North, Range 22 West of the $6^{\rm th}$ P.M. in Gosper County.
- 3. Allan Thomson MacDougall, P.E. of RJH Consultants, Inc., 9800 Mount Pyramid Court, Suite 330, Englewood, Colorado 80122, prepared the plans and specifications.
- 4. The Central Nebraska Public Power and Irrigation District, 415 Lincoln Street, P.O. Box 740, Holdrege, Nebraska 68949 owns the dam.
- 5. The plans and specifications were examined by a registered professional engineer of the Department and were found to be consistent with current standards.
- 6. Following consultation with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, the Department finds the project will have "No Effect" on any state listed threatened or endangered species or their critical habitat.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Application for Approval of Plans for Dams, plan P-20885 and associated specifications are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- 1. This approval will remain in effect for purposes of construction until November 1, 2024.
- 2. The owner of a dam shall provide written notice to the Department at least ten days before construction of the dam is to begin. Notices must be in writing and addressed to the Chief Engineer of the Department's Dam Safety Section. Notices may be delivered to the Department by mail, facsimile, or electronic mail.
- 3. The dam owner must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.

- B. Receive written approval prior to taking any action that changes the storage capacity of the reservoir, the specifications, plan P- 11921, or plan P-20885.
- C. Construct, operate and maintain the structure in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-241 and the *Safety of Dams and Reservoirs Act*, §§ 46-1601 to 46-1670.
- D. Assume liability for all damages due to leakage, overflow or structural failure of the dam.
- 4. Upon completion of the construction, the owner shall file with the Department the enclosed "Construction Certification Form for Dams". Following receipt of this form, an approval to continue operation of the dam will be issued by the Department if it determines that the dam is safe to impound within the limitations outlined in this approval.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.
