Data Bank Fee Schedule

Data Processing and Retrieval Costs
(Effective September 1, 2005)

A. Data Retrieved from the Data Bank Web Site No Cost

There is no cost for self-service data retrieval and download through the Internet.

B. Data Dissemination through Data Bank Time & Materials Charge

The Data Bank charges for requests that require additional processing. Charges are based on actual or average staff time and materials (T&M) required to produce requested work products. Estimated time and computer resources will be quoted at a rate of \$30 per hour.

Services offered and the related bases for charges are listed below.

* Listed charges reflect average actual time and materials. DVDs may be used for larger datasets - one DVD is considered equivalent to two CDs for purposes of determining charges.

** T&M charges will be computed based on staff hours incurred for data analysis and processing plus materials.

<u>Data Plots & Interpretative Maps</u>	Charges***	Examples
Map Preparation, Revision and Production	T&M	Maps processed with Topographic Features & Imagery background - includes data extract and overlay
Additional Plots (Up to 36" wide) \$20	\$10 per map - up to 48" long per map - 49" to 72" long	

*** T&M charges will be computed based on staff hours incurred for preparation time plus materials for maps produced on standard plot paper.

C. Mailing Costs – Invoice will include any postage costs.

The INTERNET is the preferred mode of data dissemination. On user request, the Data Bank will upload processed data onto its own agency “FTP” site and provide user(s) with INSTRUCTIONS for retrieving requested information.

Notes:

1. Individual requesters will be billed for actual or estimated data processing costs whichever is less, including mailing costs. Cost estimates will be provided on request. The Department of Natural Resources may require a deposit prior to processing a request.
2. Data processing time includes dedicated staff time required for any programming, analysis, and production of output products in the form furnished to requestor.
3. For billing purposes, actual processing time will be determined in increments of 15 minutes.
4. All requests should be made by postal, fax or electronic mail to the Data Bank using the addresses listed in the Contact section below.
5. Due to limited resources, the Data Bank undertakes user requests generally limited to eight hours of data processing time.
6. Processing fees may be waived on requests by work-share and participating governments or governmental agencies at the discretion of the Department of Natural Resources.
