Complete Items 1 through 3 by printing in ink or typing the appropriate information. The following information shall be submitted with this form on 8½-inch by 11-inch paper or folded to such a size, identified in an index and made a part hereof:

- A. A fee schedule which includes:
 - (1) The amount of the fees requested.
 - (2) The time period for which the fees shall apply.
 - (3) Date when the fees will first be assessed.
 - (4) If fees are not uniform for the entire geographic area, a map showing the areas to which each variation in fees applies and an explanation for the different rates.
- B. Sufficient information to allow the Department to determine the economic necessity to recover costs.
- C. The source of the water stored or to be stored underground.
- D. An explanation of the underground water storage method.
- E. The relative amounts of water stored or to be stored underground and naturally occurring ground water.
- F. The data or reference studies used by the applicant to determine the underground water storage.
- G. A description of the areas served or to be served by the water stored underground and a map showing the boundary.
- H. The amount of surface water, if any, for which the applicant has an appropriation.
- I. The manner, use, and location of any such surface water appropriation.
