NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF NONUSE

- 1. Department records show that Surface Water Appropriation A-10139 is held by **Terry and Cheryl Beth Frisch**.
- 2. Appropriation A-10139 has a priority date of January 10, 1963, and authorizes use of water for irrigation on 32.3 acres, described below. Water may be diverted from the Elkhorn River at points of diversion on both banks of the stream, located in the NE¼NE¼ of Section 05, Township 29 North, Range 14 West of the 6th P.M., in Holt County. The maximum diversion rate shall not exceed 0.46 cubic feet per second (cfs) from all points of diversion.

- 3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that Appropriation A-10139 has not been used for irrigation for more than five consecutive years, as required by Nebraska law.
- 4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04.
- 5. Pursuant to **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02,** this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-10139 will be **cancelled** unless this determination is successfully contested.
- 6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
 - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-10139.
 - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) no later than **December 12**, **2025**. **No filing fee** is required.
