NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF NONUSE

OF SURFACE WATER APPROPRIATION A-15308

- 1. Department records show that Surface Water Appropriation A-15308 is held by **Darrell Hoesing**.
- 2. Appropriation A-15308 has a priority date of August 4, 1978, and authorizes the appropriator to store 5.7 acre-feet of water in Hoesing Brothers Reservoir located in the NE½NE½ and extending into the SE½NE⅓ of Section 26, Township 33 North, Range 01 West of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County. The source of water is Antelope Creek with the pump located in the SW¼NW¼ of Section 25 of said legal description.
- 3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that Hoesing Brothers Reservoir was breached and no longer stores water.
- 4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04.
- 5. Pursuant to **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02,** this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-15308 will be **cancelled** unless this determination is successfully contested.
- 6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
 - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-15308.
 - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) no later than **January 8, 2026**. **No filing fee is** required.
