- 1. Department records show that Surface Water Appropriation A-8491 is held by Todd D. and Joyce S. Miller.
- 2. Appropriation A-8491 has a priority date of April 17, 1956, and authorizes use of water for irrigation on 45 acres, described below. Water may be diverted from the Elkhorn River at a a point of diversion located on the south bank of the stream in the NW\SE\delta of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 12 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County. The maximum diversion rate shall not exceed 0.35 cubic feet per second (cfs).

- 3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that Appropriation A-8491 has not been used for irrigation for more than five consecutive years, as required by Nebraska law.
- 4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04.
- 5. Pursuant to **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02,** this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-8491 will be **cancelled** unless this determination is successfully contested.
- 6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
 - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-8491.
 - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) no later than **December 18**, **2025**. **No filing fee** is required.
