- 1. Department records show that Surface Water Appropriation A-8768 is held by **John and Mary Krysl**.
- 2. Appropriation A-8768 has a priority date of August 23, 1956, and authorizes use of water for irrigation on 88.0 acres, described below. Water may be diverted from the Elkhorn River at a points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the NW4SW4 of Section 22, Township 30 North, Range 15 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County. The maximum diversion rate shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second (cfs) from all points of diversion.

- 3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that Appropriation A-8768 has not been used for irrigation for more than five consecutive years, as required by Nebraska law.
- 4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04.
- 5. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02, this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-8768 will be cancelled unless this determination is successfully contested.
- 6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
 - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-8768.
 - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) no later than **January 19**, **2026**. **No filing fee is required**.
