**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF NONUSE
OF SURFACE WATER APPROPRIATION A-16506**

WATER DIVISION 2-B

1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-16506 is held by **Timothy R. and Helen Larson.**
2. Appropriation A-16506 has a priority date of **July 17, 1986,** and authorizes the appropriator to store **23.5 acre-feet** of water from **Cache Creek** in **Cache Creek Reservoir No. 10** located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$** of **Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 10 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County.**
3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that **Cache Creek Dam No. 10,** approved for storage under Appropriation A-16506, was breached and has not retained water for storage for **more than five consecutive years,** as required by Nebraska law.
4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04.**
5. Pursuant to **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02,** this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-16506 will be **cancelled** unless this determination is successfully contested.
6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
 - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-16506.
 - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) **by 5:00 P.M. on April 23, 2026. No filing fee is required.**
