ORDER OF PROVISIONAL RELINQUISHMENT (CANCELLATION) PREL-9625

AND NOTIFICATION FOR REASSIGNMENT REA-9626

FOR WATER APPROPRIATIONS A-19477

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-19477 is held by Farwell Irrigation District (District).
- 2. Appropriation A-19477 has a priority date of October 26, 2016, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of 273.6 acres of land. The water may be diverted from Sherman Reservoir (storage appropriation A-4923B) via the headgate of the Farwell Irrigation District Main Canal located in the SW4NW4 of Section 01, Township 15 North, Range 14 West of the 6th P.M. in Sherman County. Water diverted shall not exceed 273.6 acre-feet.
- 3. On April 8, 2022, the District and individual owners filed provisional relinquishment PREL-9625 relinquishing the right to irrigate 38.5 acres of land under appropriation A-19477.
- On April 8, 2022, the District filed in the Department Notification for Reassignment REA-9626 to assign the 38.5 acres of land previously relinquished.

ORDER

- IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
- 1. Part of appropriation A-19477 in the amount of 38.5 acre feet of water from Sherman Reservoir for use upon 38.5 acres of land is CANCELLED.
- The Department acknowledges REA-9626 to reassign the 38.5 acres of water under appropriation A-19477 previously relinguished for use upon the land described below.

- 2. All terms and conditions of previous orders for appropriation A-19477 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
- 3. The appropriator shall file a map of all lands to be irrigated within six months of the signing date of this Order.
- Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04(5) the District may assign, within 5 years of the Order of Cancellation by the Department, the relinquished portion of an appropriation.
- 5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Receiving approval prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, a transfer of the location of the place of use, a relinquishment of a portion of the appropriation, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
 - B. Notify the Department of Natural Resources of any reassignment of relinquished portions of an appropriation.
 - C. Comply with all relevant notices and orders of the Department.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.
