ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-14126

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-14126 is held by Douglas and Heather Plouzek.
- 2. A review of Department records indicates a scrivener's error was made on the map approval dated March 11, 1977. The correct point of diversion is in Section 31, Township 10 North, Range 07 East of the 6th P.M. in Lancaster County rather than in Section 21 of said legal description as stated on the Order approving map number 12108.
- 3. Appropriation A-14126 has a priority date of March 29, 1976, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 0.44 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Antelope Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE4SE4 of Section 31, Township 10 North, Range 07 East of the 6th P.M. in Lancaster County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.01 cfs from all points of diversion.

Township 10 North, Range 07 East of the 6th P.M. in Lancaster County Acres

Section 31: NE¹/₄SE¹/₄ 0.44

4. On January 27, 2023, Douglas and Heather Plouzek filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-9850, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-14126 for use upon the land described above.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-14126 is CANCELLED.
