ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-15521

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-15521 is held by the University of Nebraska.
- 2. Appropriation A-15521 with a priority date of July 13, 1979, authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 80 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Silver Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW4SE4 of Section 35, Township 14 North, Range 08 East of the 6th P.M. in Saunders County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.14 cfs.

- 3. The Department has received information concerning the use of surface water appropriation A-15521 that indicates the appropriation has not been used for its required purpose for more than five consecutive years.
- 4. On March 30, 2023, the Department issued a Notice of Preliminary Determination of Nonuse of appropriation A-15521. The Notice was delivered by certified mail to Mark Schroeder, Director, University of Nebraska, Ag Resources & Development Center, 1071 County Road G, Ithaca, Nebraska 68033.
- 5. No contest of the Preliminary Determination of Nonuse was received in the Department.
- 6. The Department has determined that appropriation A-15521 has not been used for its required purpose for more than five consecutive years.
- 7. Nebraska Revised Statutes § 46-229.02 provides that an appropriation not used for a beneficial purpose for more than five consecutive years may be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-15521 is CANCELLED.
