APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19937 AND MAP NUMBER 21264

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On July 24, 2023, Larry Guertz, on behalf of Blade Masters Ground Maintenance, Inc., and Tim Carmicheal, on behalf of the City of Omaha (City), filed in the Department application A-19937 for a temporary Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 21264.
2. Temporary permits may be granted for a term of up to one year.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19937 and map number 21264 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the Missouri River.
2. Water will be used for the purpose of foundation repair on City park property.
3. The priority date is July 24, 2023.
4. Water will be withdrawn at a point of diversion in the Lot 1 of Section 13, Township 15 North, Range 13 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Douglas County.
5. The rate water may be diverted under appropriation A-19937 shall not exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second (9,000 gallons per minute). The total amount of water diverted shall not exceed 10 acre-feet.
6. This appropriation EXPIRES one year from the date of this Order and appropriation A-19937 will be CANCELLED without further action by the Department as of that date.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation.
  - B. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
