BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-3702 is held by Jay D. and Phylis Anderson.
- 2. Appropriation A-3702 has a priority date of March 27, 1944, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 12.6 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion located on the south bank of the stream in the NW4NE4 of Section 30, Township 16 North, Range 09 West of the 6th P.M. in Howard County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.18 cfs.
