APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-9892 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-8589

AND MAP NUMBER 21184

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-8589 is held by South Loup Valley Ash Creek Ranch, Inc.
2. Appropriation A-8589 has a priority date of May 28, 1956, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 65.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the South Loup River at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 07, Township 14 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 110 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.59 cfs.

3. On March 10, 2023, James E. Jones, on Behalf of South Loup Valley Ash Creek Ranch, Inc., filed application EXT-9892 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-8589.
4. On October 2, 2023, James E. Jones filed map number 21184 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-8589 through transfer EXT-9892.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-9892 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 21184 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-8589 shall be shown in the Departments records authorizing the use of water to irrigate 65.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21184, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the South Loup River at a point of diversion located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sectionn 07, Township 14 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County, as depicted on map number 21184. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 110 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.59 cfs (265 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-8589 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. A measuring device, approved by the Department, may be required if so ordered by the Department.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Order may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
