ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-13666

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-13666 is held by Richard and Rose A. Komenda.
2. Appropriation A-13666 has a priority date of July 21, 1975, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 27.3 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from a tributary to North Oak Creek at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 06, Township 13 North, Range 05 East of the 6th P.M. in Saunders County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.39 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. On December 20, 2023, Richard and Rose A. Komenda filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-10110, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-13666 for use upon the land described above.
