# ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-19310

# FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

#### WATER DIVISION 2-A

#### BACKGROUND

- 1. On November 20, 2014, David and Barbara J. Pomplun filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19310 for a permit to impound water from the South Loup River into a former meander of the river that has become separated from the flow of water (oxbow) for the purpose of maintaining the water level for fish and recreation.
- 2. The applicant requested 8.5 acre-feet per year to be stored in the oxbow located in the SE $^{1}$ ASE $^{1}$ A of Section 10, Township 14 North, Range 21 West of the  $6^{th}$  P.M. in Custer County.
- 3. The Department has received information that the applicant does not intend to move forward with this application and that it should be dismissed.
