ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-19310

FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. On November 20, 2014, David and Barbara J. Pomplun filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19310 for a permit to impound water from the South Loup River into a former meander of the river that has become separated from the flow of water (oxbow) for the purpose of maintaining the water level for fish and recreation.
2. The applicant requested 8.5 acre-feet per year to be stored in the oxbow located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 14 North, Range 21 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County.
3. The Department has received information that the applicant does not intend to move forward with this application and that it should be dismissed.
