APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-10068 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-13893

AND MAP NUMBER 21350

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-13893 is held by Stanley O. and Jenny M. Roebke.
2. Appropriation A-13893 has a priority date of December 4, 1975, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 43.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Lincoln Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 03, Township 11 North, Range 02 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.61 cfs.

3. On January 17, 2024, Stanley O. Roebke filed application EXT-10068 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 21350 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-13893 through transfer EXT-10068.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-10068 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 21350 are APPROVED.
2. Appropriation A-13893 through transfer EXT-10068 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 43.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21350, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Lincoln Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 03 and the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, all in Township 11 North, Range 02 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County, as depicted on map number 21350. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.61 cfs from all points of diversion (274 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed three acre-feet

per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of previous orders for appropriation A-13893 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. This appropriation is subject to the provisions of the Blue River Compact and could be closed if Compact flows are not being met.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Order may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
