ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-8616

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-8616 is held by Jon R. Reins.
2. Appropriation A-8616 has a priority date of June 15, 1956, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 44.8 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Loup River, via the Columbus-Genoa Canal, at a point of diversion located in the NW¼ of Section 06, Township 16 North, Range 04 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County. Water is withdrawn from the canal in the SE¼SE¼ of Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 02 West of the 6th P.M. in Platte County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.32 cfs.

3. On April 29, 2024, Jon R. Reins filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-10239, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-8616 for use upon the land described above.
