# ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN PART OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-13780

### AND APPROVAL OF MAP NUMBER 21461

### WATER DIVISION 1-D

### BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-13780 is held by Shirley Sloup, Bill Sloup and R. Scott and Glenda M. Sloup.
- 2. Appropriation A-13780 has a priority date of August 29, 1975, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 139.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the E½NW¼, SW¾NE¾ and NE⅓SE¾ of Section 36, Township 12 North, Range 02 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.99 cfs from all points of diversion. The total annual volume may not exceed three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

3. On August 26, 2024, Shirley Sloup, Bill Sloup and R. Scott and Glenda M. Sloup filed relinquishment REL-10225, relinquishing the right to divert water under a portion of appropriation A-13780 to irrigate the 54.6 acres of land described below.

#### ORDER

### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Part of appropriation A-13780 at the rate of 0.78 cfs for use upon the 54.6 acres of land described above is CANCELLED.
- 2. Appropriation A-13780 now authorizes the appropriator to divert water from the Big Blue River to irrigate the 84.4 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21461 which is made a part of this Order. The points of diversion remain in the E½NW¾, SW¾NE¾ and NE¾SE¾ of Section 36, Township 12 North, Range 02 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County, as depicted on map number 21461. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.21 cfs (543 gallons per minute) from all points of diversion. The total volume may not exceed three acre-feet per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

- 3. All terms and conditions of previous orders for appropriation A-13780 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
- 4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
- B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
- C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.
