ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17883A

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17883A is held by Jon R. Reins.
- 2. Appropriation A-17883A has a priority date of June 30, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 88.7 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Loup River via the headgate of the Columbus-Genoa Canal at a point of diversion located on the NE4NW4 of Section 06, Township 16 North, Range 04 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County and withdrawn from the Canal in the NW4NE4 and the NE4NE4 of Section 32, Township 18 North, Range 02 West of the 6th P.M. in Platte County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.64 cfs.
