APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-20049 AND MAP NUMBER 21542

FOR A TEMPORARY PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

On November 12, 2024, Jerry Henscheid, on behalf of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska and Iowa, filed in the Department application A-20049 for a temporary permit to appropriate water.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-20049 and map number 21542 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the Blackbird Creek.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of filling a dry sewer lagoon.
3. The priority date is November 12, 2024.
4. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 10 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Thurston County as depicted on map number 21542 which is made a part of this Order.
5. The rate that water may be diverted under appropriation A-20049 shall not exceed 1.55 cubic foot per second (700 gallons per minute). The total amount of water diverted shall not exceed 16.4 acre-feet.
6. This appropriation EXPIRES three months from the date of this Order and appropriation A-20049 will be CANCELLED without further action by the Department as of that date.
7. A measuring device approved by the Department may be required if so ordered by the Department.
8. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, contractors, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
