DISMISSAL OF TRANSFER APPLICATION NEX-9016

FOR SURFACE WATER APPROPRIATION A-10123

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-10123 is held by Robert J. and Susan M. Malander, Trustees.
- 2. Appropriation A-10123 has a priority date of November 15, 1962, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of 124 acres of land. The water may be diverted from the Cedar River at a point of diversion located on left bank of the stream in the NW4NE4 of Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 07 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.77 cfs.
- 3. On November 20, 2020, Robert J. Malander filed application NEX-9016 in the Department for a permit for a non-expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated under appropriation A-10123.
- 4. On December 3, 2024, Robert J. Malander filed correspondence in the Department requesting dismissal of NEX-9016.
- 5. Therefore, application NEX-9016 should be dismissed.

Application NEX-9016 for a non-expedited transfer is DISMISSED.
