ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-20013

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-20013 is held by Aaron and Dianna Gruber.
- 2. Appropriation A-20013 has a priority date of April 24, 2024, and authorizes the appropriator to store 8.0 acre-feet of supplemental storage water in Gruber Pond. Gruber Pond is located in the SE4SE4 of Section 26, Township 12 North, Range 01 West of the 6th P.M. in York County.
- 3. On June 10, 2024, the Department approved application A-20013. The approval of application A-20013 was conditional upon a plan of reservoir filed within six months of the signing date of the application approval.
- 4. The plan of reservoir for Gruber Pond was not filed by the deadline date of December 10, 2024.
- 5. Therefore, appropriation A-20013 should be cancelled.
- 6. Nebraska Revised Statutes § 46-238 provide for the cancellation of an appropriation in the event that the appropriator fails to comply with the terms of the Order.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that appropriation A-20013 is CANCELLED.
