ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN PART OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17887

AND APPROVAL OF MAP NUMBER 21562

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17887 is held by C. David Elm.
2. Appropriation A-17887 has a priority date of July 14, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 66.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Looking Glass Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 08, Township 17 North, Range 03 West of the 6th P.M. in Platte County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed 0.47 cubic feet per second (cfs) from all points of diversion.

3. On April 11, 2025, Jeremy Schreiber, on behalf of C. David Elm, filed relinquishment REL-11203, relinquishing the right to divert water under a portion of appropriation A-17887 to irrigate the 50.7 acres of land described below.

4. Appropriation A-17887 provides additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-8133.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Part of appropriation A-17887 at the rate of 0.36 cfs for use upon the 50.7 acres of land described above is CANCELLED.
2. Appropriation A-17887 now authorizes the appropriator to divert water to irrigate the 15.3 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21562 which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Looking Glass Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 08, Township 17 North, Range 03 West of the 6th P.M. in Platte County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.11 cfs (49 gallons per minute). The total volume of all appropriations may not exceed three acre-feet per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-17887 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.
