APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-20097 AND MAP NUMBER 21617

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On May 13, 2025, David Dowdy, on behalf of Peru State College, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-20097 for a temporary Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On May 30, 2025, David Dowdy filed in the Department map number 21617 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-20097.
3. Construction has been completed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-20097 and map number 21617 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-20097 as depicted on map number 21617 which is made a part of this Order.

2. Appropriation A-20097 has a priority date of May 13, 2025, and authorizes the appropriator the use of 0.38 cubic foot per second (cfs) (170 gallons per minute) of water for establishing landscape vegetation on the 1.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Missouri River at a point of diversion located the right bank of the stream in the Lot 03 of Section 14, Township 06 North, Range 15 East of the 6th P.M. in Nemaha County, as depicted on map number 21617.
3. Only the land shown on map number 21617 may be irrigated under appropriation A-20097 unless a change is authorized by subsequent Order of the Department.
4. Appropriation A-20097 EXPIRES one year from the date of this Order and will be cancelled without furth action by the Department as of that date.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:

- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
- B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Order may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If in the future you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, and if there are junior appropriations upstream, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.
