ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-11634

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-11634 is held by Circle A, LLC.
- 2. Appropriation A-11634 has a priority date of February 3, 1969, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 29.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the North Loup River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in Lot 01 and Lot 02 of Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 17 West of the 6th P.M. in Loup County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.41 cfs from all points of diversion.

- 3. On December 6, 2024, Max T. Wake, on behalf of Circle A, LLC, filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-10822, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-11634 for use upon the land described above conditional on conversion to a groundwater well.
- 4. On August 5, 2025, correspondence was received in the Department that the new well is working and the relinquishment may be moved forward.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-11634 is CANCELLED.
