ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-20010

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-20010 is held by Patricia Anderson.
- 2. Appropriation A-20010 has a priority date of April 22, 2024, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 19.7 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SW4SE4 of Section 08, Township 15 North, Range 09 West of the 6th P.M. in Howard County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.28 cfs.
