### ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN PART OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-13397

### AND APPROVAL OF MAP NUMBER 21702

WATER DIVISION 2-B

#### BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-13397 is held by Fascianella Farm, LLC; Labrador Bay Barn LLC; Chris Kelsay; Chad Wegener; and Beau Baltzell.
- 2. Appropriation A-13397 has a priority date of February 11, 1975, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 95.2 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Elkhorn River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW4NE4 and NW4SE4 of Section 16, Township 14 North, Range 10 East of the 6th P.M. in Sarpy County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.36 cfs from all points of diversion. The total annual volume may not exceed three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

3. The Department has received information concerning the use of surface water appropriation A-13397 and determined that the appropriation has not been used for irrigation purposes for more than five consecutive years as required under Nebraska law. At this time, the Department knows of no reason that constitutes sufficient cause for nonuse under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04

4. On October 17, 2025, Leo Fascianella, on behalf of Fascianella Farm, LLC, and Chris Kelsay filed relinquishments REL-11494 and REL-11496, respectively, relinquishing the right to divert water under a portion of appropriation A-13397 to irrigate the 54.6 acres of land described below.

Upon completion of this Order of Cancellation for the preceding portion of land authorized for irrigation under A-13397, the Department will proceed with issuing a Notice of Preliminary Determination of Nonuse (PDNU) for the remaining appurtenant land owned by Labrador Bay Barn LLC; Chad Wegener; and Beau Baltzell in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02

#### ORDER

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Part of appropriation A-13397 at the rate of 0.78 cfs for use upon the 54.6 acres of land described above is **CANCELLED**.
- Authorized Land for Irrigation, Priority and Diversion Rate
  Appropriation A-13397 now authorizes the appropriator to divert water
  from the Elkhorn River to irrigate the 40.6 acres of land described below
  and depicted on map number 21702 which is made a part of this Order. The
  points of diversion are in the SW4NE4 and NW4SE4 of Section 16,
  Township 14 North, Range 10 East of the 6th P.M. in Sarpy County, as
  depicted on map number 21702. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio
  of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of
  0.58 cfs (260 gallons per minute) from all points of diversion. The
  total volume may not exceed three acre-feet per irrigated acre per year
  nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of
  crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

# 3. Terms & Conditions of Previous Order(s)

All terms and conditions of the approval of appropriation A-13397 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

## 4. Ongoing Statutory Requirements

- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
- B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
- C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Department may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, you may call for water by contacting your local field office
