ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-14825

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-14825 is held by the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District.
- 2. Appropriation A-14825 has a priority date of March 18, 1977, and authorizes the use of water from Salt Creek Reservoir 35 for irrigation of 46.4 acres of land located in the NSW4 of Section 27, Township 08 North, Range 07 East of the 6th P.M. in Lancaster County. The water may be measured from pump sites located in the NSW4 of Section 27 of said legal description. Water diverted shall not exceed 40.60 acre-feet per annum.
- 3. On December 3, 2025, David Potter, General Manager, Lower Platte South Natural Resources District, filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-11540, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-14825.
