ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17731

BACKGROUND

- 1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17731 is held by the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District.
- 2. Appropriation A-17731 has a priority date of February 10, 1999, and authorizes the use of water from Oak-Middle Reservoir 66-A for irrigation of 75.0 acres of land located in the SE4 of Section 29, Township 13 North, Range 04 East of the 6th P.M. in Butler County. The water shall be measured at a location of diversion in the NW4SE4 of Section 29 of said legal description. Water diverted shall not exceed 21.00 acre-feet per annum.
- 3. On December 3, 2025, David Potter, General Manager, Lower Platte South Natural Resources District, filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-11535, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-17731.
