APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-11481 AND MAP NUMBER 21670

FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-7511

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

- Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-7511 is held by Lynn R. and Amy K. Selting.
- 2. Appropriation A-7511 has a priority date of May 23, 1955, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 17.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Cedar Creek at points of diversion located on the east bank of the stream in the SE¼NE¾ of Section 03, Township 23 North, Range 06 West of the 6th P.M. in Antelope County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.12 cfs from all points of diversion.

- 3. On December 4, 2025, Lynn R. Selting filed application EXT-11481 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-7511 and map number 21670 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-7511 through transfer EXT-11481.
- 4. On December 4, 2025, Lynn R. Selting also filed relinquishment REL-11511, relinquishing the right to divert water under a portion of appropriation A-7511 to irrigate 8.2 acres of the 17.0 acres of land described above.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

- 1. Part of appropriation A-7511 at the rate of 0.06 cfs for use upon the 8.2 acres of land described above is **CANCELLED**.
- 2. Application EXT-11481 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 21670 are **APPROVED**.

3. Authorized Land for Irrigation

Appropriation A-7511 through transfer EXT-11481 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 4.4 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21670, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Cedar Creek at points of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 03, Township 23 North, Range 06 West of the 6th P.M. in Antelope County, as depicted on map number 21670. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.06 cfs from all points of diversion (27 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed three acre-feet per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

4. Terms & Conditions of Previous Order(s)

All terms and conditions of appropriation A-7511 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

5. Measuring Device

A measuring device, approved by the Department and at the Applicant's expense, may be required if so ordered by the Department.

6. Ongoing Statutory Requirements

The appropriator must:

- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
- B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
- C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with applicable laws, Department Orders, or the terms of this Order may result in cancellation, suspension, administrative penalties, or criminal prosecution.

Under Nebraska law, failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for **more than five consecutive years** for its approved purpose may result in its cancellation.

This appropriation does not guarantee water availability. Senior appropriations have legal priority. If insufficient water is available, junior appropriators may be closed. Appropriators may request enforcement action by contacting the local field office.
