**ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN PART OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-19892  
AND APPROVAL OF MAP NUMBER 21714**

WATER DIVISION 1-F

**BACKGROUND**

1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-19892 is held by Lynn and Elaine Binder, Todd and April Binder and Tyler and Valerie Binder.
2. Appropriation A-19892 has a priority date of **January 30, 2023**, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the **151.3 acres** of land described below. The water may be diverted from **the North Fork of the Big Nemaha River** at a point of diversion located on **left bank** of the stream in the **NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>** of **Section 06, Township 03 North, Range 12 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Pawnee County**. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 2.16 cfs. The total annual volume may not exceed **three** acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

3. The approval of appropriation A-19892 was conditional upon the irrigation of the above land by September 1, 2025.
4. Department personnel performed a field investigation and determined a portion of the land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-19892 had not been irrigated by September 1, 2025.
5. **Nebraska Revised Statutes § 46-229.02(7)** provides for the cancellation of unused portions of surface water appropriations.

ORDER

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Part of appropriation A-19589 at a rate of 0.36 for use upon 25.3 acres of land is **CANCELLED**.
2. **Authorized Land for Irrigation After BUC-11548**  
Appropriation A-19892 now permits the appropriator to divert water from **the North Fork of the Big Nemaha River** to irrigate the 126 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 21714 which is made a part of this Order.

3. **Diversion Rate**  
The water may be diverted from **the North Fork of the Big Nemaha River** at a point of diversion located in the **NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>** of **Section 06, Township 03 North, Range 12 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Pawnee County**, as depicted on map number 21714. Water diverted shall not exceed a maximum rate of 1.8 cfs (808 gallons per minute).
4. **Terms & Conditions of Previous Order(s)**  
All terms and conditions of the approval of appropriation A-19892 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
5. **Ongoing Statutory Requirements**  
The appropriator must:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Failure to comply with applicable laws, Department Orders, or the terms of this Order may result in cancellation, suspension, administrative penalties, or criminal prosecution.

Under Nebraska law, failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for **more than five consecutive years** for its approved purpose may result in its cancellation ion.

This appropriation **does not guarantee** water availability. Senior appropriations have legal priority. If insufficient water is available, junior appropriators may be closed. Appropriators may request enforcement action by contacting the local field office.
