- 1) Welcome and Open Meeting Act: There was a copy of the Open Meeting Act in the room.
- 2) Publication of Meeting Notices: Notice of this meeting was published in the Kearney Hub (November 29, 2018), the North Platte Telegraph (December 4th, 2018), the Sidney Sun Telegraph (November 30, 2018), the Scottsbluff Star Herald (December 2, 2018), and the Grand Island Independent (December 4, 2018). - 3) Agenda Modifications: There were no modifications to the agenda (Attachment C)
- **4) Motion to Approve October 2, 2018 Minutes: (Attachment D)** Berge motioned to approve and Thorburn seconded. **Minutes approved.**
- 5) Approval of PBC Protocols: Item was grayed out on the agenda and no discussion occurred.
- 6) Budget Update (NeDNR): (Attachment E) Due to changes in accounting to more accurately reflect budget to cash flow, and with a motion to transfer funds from TBNRD Year 4-6 to SPNRD that was approved at the 10/2/18 PBC meeting, an error was found. \$173,250 of General Fund money obligated back to Year 1-3 was taken off twice and overinflated the balance for TBNRD. To correct the error, NeDNR will give TBNRD \$193,421.61 for years 4-6 and \$9,133.19 for year 7 to bring them back to their expected balance of \$146,505.33 of available funds from NeDNR for matching as if the error hadn't occurred. The available funding on the PBC spreadsheet will be lower than \$146,505.33 at the conclusion of this meeting due to the funding proposal brought forward by TBNRD in 6.A.i.

Motion to approve the transfer of \$193,421.61 to TBNRD's Years 4-6 (cell N10) and \$9,133.19 (cell K7) to TBNRD's Year 7 accounts to correct the accounting error found in TBNRD's Year 1-3. Lyndon motioned to approve and Berge seconded. Motion approved.

A. Funding

i) Wetland Recharge Project: (Attachment F)

- A. TBNRD is working on putting pipelines in wetlands for recharge and would like approval to use PBC funds for the purpose of delivering water to the wetlands. TBNRD is asking for approval to use PBC funding for up to \$65,000 for this and similar future projects. TBNRD requests approval from PBC administrators to allow \$65,000 in PBC funds already designated for use by TBNRD to be used to help pay for high flow diversions into Funk WPA in 2018. TBNRD would also like to have wetland water deliveries to the other waterfowl protection areas (WPAs) listed in Attachment F approved as an acceptable use of TBNRD-designated PBC funds in future years. Schellpeper motioned to approve and Vogt seconded. Motion approved.
- B. Funk Lagoon and other project locations have had perched water issues in some areas where water is causing excess water seepage problems on neighboring lands. Neighboring farmers are concerned about flooding in their fields. TBNRD has included monitoring wells to track the flow of the water put into the wetlands. Schellpeper noted that monitoring plans and excess flow permits will be included in the Annual Operating Plans. No motion or action needed.

A. Funding

i) Oliver Reservoir Streamflow Enhancement Project – Request for additional funds
Discussion of Memo from SPNRD to NeDNR (Attachment F). SPNRD has identified
two landowners willing to permanently decertify irrigated acres, which would be
beneficial to this project by increasing streamflow to Lodgepole Creek. Proposal is to
cover the total cost (\$448,750) for two retirements, which is \$91,495.39 short of the
project's current contract budget (\$357,254.61). To make-up for the additional cost,
it is proposed that \$54,896.83 is moved from TBNRD's Budget Years 4-6 budgeted
funds, to SPNRD's Budget Years 4-6 budgeted funds. Following this transfer, the
total final financial obligations for the Oliver Reservoir project will be: SPNRD = \$
221,398.56 (40%) and NeDNR = \$332,096.83 (60%) for a total budget of
\$553,495.39. This is higher than the cost of the two retirements (\$448,750) because
of previous work under the contract.

Motion: To transfer \$54,896.83 from Budget Years 4-6 from TBNRD to SPNRD to cover the Oliver Streamflow Project retirements.

Thorburn motioned. Vogt seconded. The motion passed with all ayes.

Action Item: NeDNR will make change to the PBC spreadsheets to reflect movement of funds

Subject: High Platte Flow Diversions into Rainwater Basin wetlands; WRCF

requirements

Tri-Basin NRD is partnering with the Rainwater Basin Joint Venture, the US Fish and Wildlife Service and Central NE Public Power and Irrigation District (CNPPID) to enable delivery of excess Platte River flows through the CNPPID canal system to several Rainwater Basin wetlands in the Platte Basin in Phelps and Gosper counties. Tri-Basin would like to utilize PBC funds to cost-share on these diversions.

The wetlands associated with this project are all owned by the US Fish and Wildlife Service and are operated as Waterfowl Production Areas (WPAs). WPAs that will be able to accept excess flows are: Victor Lakes, Linder, Cottonwood, Johnson and Funk (see attached map). Tri-Basin has previously paid to divert water into Cottonwood WPA several times, beginning in 2013. The Platte River Recovery Implementation Program paid for high flow diversions into Funk WPA in 2013. The other WPAs don't yet have infrastructure in place for water delivery, but pipeline construction is expected to begin over the winter. WRCF funds are already approved and designated for pipeline construction for this project.

Tri-Basin anticipates that excess flows will be available to enable diversion into Funk WPA this fall. Since Funk is the furthest south and east of these wetlands, recharge from it will likely take decades to return to the Platte. The current CoHyst model estimates that the stream accretion factor is between 10 and 30 % over 50 years. Benefits for endangered species, however, are immediate. Enhancing this large wetland with high flow diversions creates suitable habitat for migrating Whooping Cranes. Funk has multiple documented instances of Whooping Cranes visiting the wetland over the past 30 years.

Tri-Basin NRD requests approval from PBC administrators to allow \$65,000 in PBC funds already designated for use by Tri-Basin NRD to be used to help pay for high flow diversions into Funk WPA in 2018. We would also like to have wetland water deliveries to the other WPAs listed above approved as an acceptable use of TBNRD-designated PBC funds in future years. Under the WRCF statutes, this project would meet the requirements of both increasing streamflows and enhancing groundwater recharge. Thank you for your consideration of this request.
