The completed application must be submitted with:

1. An application fee in the amount of \$12.50.
2. A detailed description of the planned use of groundwater including a statement as to whether it will be a new or expanded use of groundwater. If it will entail a new or expanded use of groundwater describe the anticipated daily (gallons per day) or seasonal use and provide an estimate of the amount of water to be withdrawn on an annual basis in acre-feet. If it will not be a new or expanded use of groundwater, then explain the historical daily (gallons per day) or seasonal and annual amounts used (in acre-feet); and describe the original source of the groundwater that this new well will be replacing.
3. An aerial photograph or a scaled drawing indicating:
 - a. the number of feet the proposed well will be drilled from the existing well;
 - b. locations of the proposed and existing well;
 - c. if the proposed well is for irrigation, crosshatch the acres to be irrigated; and
 - d. Township, Range, and Section boundaries.

A waiver of objections to the drilling of the proposed well, signed by the existing well owner, is optional.
