## MINIMUM STATUTORY SPACING

The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) approves Application WSP-125, for a permit to drill an irrigation well within 600 feet of existing irrigation well G-009333, submitted by James and Theresa Wilson.

The terms and conditions of permit WSP-125 are as follows:

- The irrigation well, which has been constructed, is located in the NE¼SW¼ of Section 06, Township 08 North, Range 15 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Buffalo County, shall be properly registered pursuant to the requirements of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-602(1).
- 2. Approval of this permit is based on the information included and representations made in Application WSP-125 by the applicants. That information and those representations are considered terms of this approval, to which the applicants must adhere.
- 3. The well shall be operated in compliance with all Nebraska statutes and all rules and regulations promulgated by the Central Platte Natural Resources District.
