APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT WATER IN STREAM CHANNELS

INSTRUCTIONS

For Department Use Only

This form must be completed in ink or typewritten. The form may be used by persons wishing to conduct water in stream channels for either consumptive or nonconsumptive (instream) purposes. A complete application shall include the following, submitted on 8 1/2" x 11" paper, or paper folded to that size:

- 1. Completion of Items 1 through 9.
2. A map marked to show:
a. location of contributing source (stream, pump, well, reservoir);
b. point(s) at which water is conducted into the stream;
c. entire stream reach through which the water will be conducted;
d. location(s) of diversion out of the stream or, in case of instream uses, location where such protection of the water is to end; and
e. location of use. If for irrigation, submit U.S.D.A. aerial photograph(s) with the lands in each 40-acre subdivision crosshatched and labeled with the number of acres in each subdivision to be irrigated.
3. Applicant's detailed analysis for losses in transit.
