NOTICE OF PETITION RLP-9682 FOR A PERMIT

TO CHANGE THE LOCATION OF DIVERSION

Valley and Garfield Counties

Water Division 2-A

On July 19, 2022, Bernard Glos, Office Administrator of the Twin Loups Reclamation District, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) petition RLP-9682 requesting to change the location of diversion for surface water appropriation A-19626B.

Water appropriation A-19626B, with a priority date of January 28, 2019, is a permit to divert 1.43 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water from the North Branch of Mira Creek located on both banks of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 14 West and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19, Township 18 North, Range 13 West of the 6th P.M. all in Valley County to irrigate 100 acres of land.

The applicant proposes to relocate the point of diversion of appropriation A-19626B to the Calamus River at the headgate of the Mirdan Canal located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 06, Township 21 North, Range 16 West of the 6 P.M. in Garfield County, for irrigation of 100 acres of land in the amount of 1.43 cfs.
