APPROVAL OF APPLICATION CWG-6116 AND MAP NUMBER 19893

FOR A PERMIT TO CONDUCT GROUNDWATER

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On February 22, 2017, Anthony Ahern filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application CWG-6116 for a permit to conduct water from groundwater well G-177146 into Ahern Reservoir No. 1 (storage appropriation A-19499) and remove a portion of the same water.
2. This application requests the act of conducting groundwater. The Nemaha Natural Resources District was consulted and has no objections.
3. On April 17, 2017, Anthony Ahern filed map number 19893 showing the project proposed under application CWG-6116.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application CWG-6116 and map number 19893 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water to be conducted is from groundwater well G-177146 located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 03 North, Range 15 East of the 6th P.M. in Richardson County.
2. The groundwater will be released and measured into Ahern Reservoir No. 1 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 03 North, Range 15 East of the 6th P.M. in Richardson County at a rate of 200 gallons per minute (gpm).
3. The water may be withdrawn from a pump site located on the left bank of the Ahern Reservoir No. 1 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 03 North, Range 15 East of the 6th P.M. in Richardson County.
4. Map number 19893 depicts the location of the groundwater well; reservoir; location of where water is conducted into the reservoir; diversion works; location of diversion out of the reservoir; and location of the use of water.
5. The Department retains the right to make adjustments to the amount of loss in transit. Transit loss includes that amount of water lost to seepage in the system used to convey the water to the point of discharge into Ahern Dam No. 1 reservoir.

6. A measuring device, approved by the Department, is required to be installed to meter the amount of water entering the reservoir for the purpose of irrigation and related to conducting water under conduct water permit CWG-6116.
7. A measuring device, approved by the Department, is required to be installed to meter the amount of water withdrawn from the reservoir for the purpose of irrigation and related to conducting water under conduct water permit CWG-6116.
8. The Department retains the right to require additional measuring devices, approved by the Department, at any point of discharge into or out of the project.
9. The measured volume of groundwater withdrawn from Ahern Reservoir No. 1 shall be no more than the measured volume of groundwater inflow to the reservoir.
10. The following is a description of the land proposed to be irrigated with water conducted under CWG-6116 as depicted on map number 19893 and is made a part of this Order:

11. Additional measuring, instrumentation or reporting requirements may be required as needed for the Department to efficiently administer water use in Water Division 1-F.
12. The permit holder is liable for any damages resulting from the activity authorized under this permit.
13. This permit approves the act of conducting water. Use of groundwater being conducted is authorized by the Nemaha Natural Resources District.
14. This permit may be cancelled if the permit holder fails to conduct water for more than five consecutive years.

15. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-252, the permit holder shall not be exempt from obtaining any other permits required by law.
