APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-7192 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-2029  
AND MAP NUMBER 20325

WATER DIVISION 1-B

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2029 is held by Peterson Livestock, Inc.
2. Appropriation A-2029 has a priority date of September 18, 1928, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 92.4 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, and from the Republican River in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, both in Township 03 North, Range 20 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Harlan County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 74 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.26 cfs from all points of diversion.

On December 10, 2018, Kevin Peterson, on behalf of Peterson Livestock, Inc., filed application EXT-7192 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-2029 and map number 20325 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-2029 through transfer EXT-7192.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-7192 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 20325 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-2029 through transfer EXT-7192 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 92.4 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 20325, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, and from the Republican River in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, both in Township 03 North, Range 20 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Harlan County as depicted on map number 20325. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 74 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.26 cfs from all points of diversion (565 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 2.86 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year nor to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-2029 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
