APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19727 AND MAP NUMBER 20570

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On August 28, 2020, Allen Schoemaker, on behalf of the City of Blair, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19727 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On September 24, 2020, Allen Schoemaker filed in the Department map number 20570 showing the proposed location of diversion under application A-19727.

ORDER


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19727 and map number 20570 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of the water is the Missouri River.
2. The water shall be used for municipal purposes.
3. Appropriation A-19727 has a priority date of August 28, 2020, and authorizes the appropriator the use of 2.23 cubic feet per second (cfs) (1,000 gallons per minute) measured at a point of diversion on the right bank of the Missouri River in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 05, Township 18 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M. in Washington County, as depicted on map number 20570, which is made a part of this Order.
4. Total amount of water diverted shall not exceed 1,615 acre-feet per annum and shall be used on an annual basis by September 1, 2030.
5. The total combined diversions under A-16120, A-17923, A-18384 and A-19727 shall not exceed 21,440,000 gallons per day measured at the location of diversion listed above.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of diversion, the location of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

7. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation. If unable to meet the conditions of approval due to an unaboidable and natural cause, a petition for an extension of time may be filed with the Department. Petitions must be filed prior to the expiration date stated in this Order and must be accompanied by a \$10.00 non-refundable filing fee.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
