APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19758 AND MAP 20685

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On March 17, 2021, Nick Ames, on behalf of the United States Air Force, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19758 for a temporary permit to appropriate water for the purpose of construction.
2. Temporary permits may not be granted for a term of more than one year.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19758 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Offutt Air Force Base Lake.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of runway construction.
3. The priority date is March 17, 2021.
4. The point of diversion is located in the SW¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 07, Township 13 North, Range 14 East of the 6th P.M. in Sarpy County as depicted on map number 20685 which is made a part of this Order.
5. The rate that water may be diverted under appropriation A-19758 shall not exceed 4.9 cubic foot per second (2,200 gallons per minute). The total amount of water diverted shall not exceed 36 acre-feet.
6. A-19758 EXPIRES one year from the date of this Order and will be cancelled without further action by the Department as of that date.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - B. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If in the future you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, and if there are junior appropriations upstream, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.
