CORRECTED ORDER OF APPROVAL FOR APPLICATION A-19746 AND MAP 20665

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On March 25, 2021, the Department of Natural Resources (Department) approved application A-19746 for a temporary permit authorizing the City of Omaha to appropriate water for the purpose of flushing a main.
2. An error on the Order of Approval dated March 25, 2021, incorrectly listed the total volume of water to be diverted as 10 acre-feet. The correct total volume of water proposed to be used is **44.5** acre-feet.

THIS ORDER CORRECTS AND REPLACES THE ORDER DATED March 25, 2021:

1. The source of water is the Missouri River.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of manufacturing.
3. The priority date is February 22, 2021.
4. The point of diversion is located in Lot 02 of Section 23, Township 15 North, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M. in Douglas County as depicted on map number 20665.
5. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed 15.6 cubic feet per second (7000 gallons per minute). The total volume of water diverted shall not exceed **44.5** acre-feet.
6. Appropriation A-19746 EXPIRES on March 25, 2022, and will be CANCELLED without further action by the Department as of that date.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
