APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19764 AND MAP NUMBER 20734

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. On April 26, 2021, Caroline F. and Marvin D. Schochenmaier filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19764 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On July 23, 2021, Caroline F. Schochenmaier filed in the Department map number 20734 showing the proposed location of withdrawal under application A-19764.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19764 and map number 20734 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is a tributary to the Niobrara River.
2. The water shall be used for domestic purposes to provide water for livestock.
3. The priority date is April 26, 2021.
4. Water may be diverted from a tributary to the Niobrara River at a point of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 04, Township 32 North, Range 11 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Holt County, as depicted on map number 20734 which is made a part of this order. Water shall be transported to a stock tank located in the abovementioned legal description. Water diverted shall not exceed the rate of 0.02 cubic feet per second (10 gallons per minute).
5. A measuring device, approved by the Department, may be required if so ordered by the Department.
6. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19764.
