APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19862 AND MAP NUMBER 21038

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

On June 21, 2022, Al Schoemaker, Director of Public Works for the City of Blair, Nebraska, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19862 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Application A-19862 and map number 21038 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the Missouri River.
2. The water shall be used for municipal purposes.
3. Appropriation A-19862 has a priority date of June 21, 2022, and authorizes the appropriator the use of 12.48 cubic feet per second (cfs) (5,600 gallons per minute) measured at a point of diversion on the right bank of the Missouri River in Lot 04 of Section 05, Township 18 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M. in Washington County, as depicted on map number 21038, which is made a part of this Order.
4. Total amount of water diverted shall not exceed 9,039 acre-feet per annum and shall be used on an annual basis by September 1, 2042.
5. The total combined diversions under A-16120, A-17923, A-18384, A-19727 and A-19862 shall not exceed 29,504,000 gallons per day measured at the location of diversion listed above.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of diversion, the location of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

7. Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.
