- b. To account for future allotment changes for NPNRD's Epic project, the NCORPE memo will need to be updated. Schellpeper explained that the current 60/40 split between the NeDNR and the NRDs will remain the same, but NeDNR's portion will be updated to cover \$1,585,689.56.

In order to meet the project goals, the original scope is being adjusted and they are currently looking at temporary and/or permanent acre retirements around the Oliver Reservoir areas.
