Meyer reported that NeDNR has been working on the SPNRD budget proposal and other contracts. Meyer also reported on the NET Grant memo describing how the NET 18-107 grant years 7-9 will come to an end on June 30th, 2020 and that NeDNR will be requesting the transfer of the remaining NET 18-107 money in April for grant year 9, whereupon NeDNR would like all dedicated funds to be obligated (ATTACHMENT F). ii. Western ID 5-year MOA budget increase (SPNRD/TPNRD)

Horn discussed a memo that described a budget increase and amendment to the Western ID 5-year MOA, where the NRD split will be revised to reflect 60% to TPNRD and 40% to SPNRD. Additionally, a flat rate fee of \$31 per af recharged through the canal will be the payment the Western Irrigation District Board will receive for the calculated credit. (ATTACHMENT H).

In a recent discussion, the TPNRD and SPNRD decided that the budget for the Western Irrigation District's 5-Year MOA #1010 needs to be increased with a revision to the split between the two NRDs (revised NRD split 60% TPNRD and 40% SPNRD). The changes are reflected below:

6. APPROVAL OF PBC FUNDING PROTOCOL

Mosier reported that NeDNR will add a footnote to table 5 of the protocol and will slate the protocol for approval during August's PBC meeting.

7. PROJECT ACTIVITIES

A. CPNRD RECHARGE PITS/DETENTION PONDS: No update.

- **B. 2020 EPIC PROGRAM (NPNRD):** Berge reported that funding for the project was approved earlier in the meeting and NPNRD will be making payments out in September. NPNRD is working with NeDNR to get the contract drafted.
- C. SCHANEMAN RECHARGE PITS (NPNRD): Berge reported that NPNRD had a productive call with NeDNR regarding the permitting application for the project. The pits are complete and the plumbing is in place. NPNRD is dealing with measurement devise issues on the inlet, but the project is essentially ready to go.
- **D. CERTIFIED ACRES REIMBURSEMENT (NPNRD):** Berge reported that all reimbursements have been received under contracts #1156 and #1157.
- **E. RAINWATER BASIN JOINT VENTURE (TBNRD):** Thorburn reported that pipelines have been laid to all 5 wetlands. The newest wetland was constructed this spring and will receive water for the first time in the fall.
- F. TRI-BASIN NRD PHASE II AUGMENTATION NORTH DRY CREEK (TBNRD): No updates.
- **G. TPNRD STREAMFLOW AUGMENTATION PIPELINE (N-CORPE):** Miller reported that TPNRD has yet to pump the north pipeline to the Platte River. Miller also reported no shortages to state protected flows have occurred yet in 2020 and that TPNRD is expecting a report soon from NeDNR regarding whether state protected flows were met in May. Miller anticipates pumping on June 7th and will, in total, pump 5,400 af of water throughout the rest of the calendar year.
- **H. J-2 REGULATING RESERVOIR (NEDNR):** Schellpeper reported NeDNR has been discussing how to redirect funding for the project to another water service agreement by 2023.
- I. EXCESS FLOW DIVERSION UPDATES (NEDNR/ NRDs): Schellpeper reported that excess flow diversions have been available this spring and that NeDNR will bring finalized dates that excess flows were taken to the August PBC meeting for approval.
